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FRPC FIREARM SAFETY RULES

*****ALWAYS ASSUME EVERY FIREARM IS LOADED*****

TREAT THEM ACCORDINGLY AT ALL TIMES

ALWAYS KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER. The only time your finger should be on the trigger is when you are at the firing line, sights on the target, and the range is HOT.

FIREARMS MAY ONLY BE LOADED WHILE THE RANGE IS HOT at the shooting benches/firing line and they will be unloaded and chamber flagged before being removed from the shooting benches/firing line. **DO NOT WALK BEHIND SHOOTING BENCHES/FIRING LINE WITH A LOADED FIREARM!**

WHEN YOU HAVE A LOADED FIREARM ON THE FIRING LINE, the firearm will stay pointed straight down range at the impact area; NO up, down, left or right. If you need to move, talk, etc., you must unload and chamber flag your firearm.

WHEN SHOOTING STANDING, the muzzle of the firearm will be in front of the shooting bench.

WHEN SHOOTING WHILE SEATED, the shooter will be seated on either the right or left side of the shooting bench.

WHEN MOVING FIREARMS FROM ONE LOCATION TO ANOTHER, they will be kept under positive control. The mechanical safety will be engaged, the action will be open, a chamber flag inserted and muzzle pointed skyward.

UNCASED FIREARMS that are not being fired will be safely benched or in rifle rack, actions open and facing upward, chambers empty, chamber flag inserted, mechanical safety engaged and muzzle pointing down range toward impact area.

DO NOT ENTER THE IMPACT AREA WHILE THE RANGE IS HOT!

FRPC RANGE COMMANDS

"**CEASE FIRE**" is called out loud 3 times. It requires you to stop firing immediately and unload/clear, open the action, insert a chamber flag and bench the firearm. All shooters and bystanders will then step back behind the red line.

"**IS THE LINE READY?**" is called out loud. Make sure everyone is behind the red line. Then call out loud "**READY ON THE RIGHT?**" and "**READY ON THE LEFT?**" followed by "**ALL READY.**"

"**THE RANGE IS COLD**" is called out loud 3 times. You may now enter the impact area to service targets. If you will not be servicing targets, you will stay behind the red line. **DO NOT HANDLE ANY FIREARMS OR AMMUNITION FOR ANY REASON.** This includes loading and unloading your magazines. The range should stay cold for 10 minutes.

"**IS THE LINE READY?**" is called out loud. Make sure everyone is behind the red line. The impact area is clear of shooters, animals, and hazards. Then call out loud "**READY ON THE RIGHT?**" and "**READY ON THE LEFT?**" followed by "**ALL READY.**"

"**THE RANGE IS HOT**" is called out loud 3 times. Shooters can now move across the red line and handle, load and fire their firearms. The range should stay hot for 20 minutes.

These 5 commands must be executed in order.

DO NOT PROCEED TO A SUBSEQUENT COMMAND UNTIL 100% COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROCEEDING COMMAND HAS BEEN VERIFIED AND ACHIEVED.

This Mutual Assurance System requires all Shooters to communicate with and watch out for one another.

ASSUME NOTHING, REMAIN VIGILANT, AND BE COURTOUS

IF YOU OBSERVE ANY UNSAFE BEHAVIOR WHILE ON FRPC PROPERTY: Notify FRPC Staff immediately!

If there isn't time to notify staff due to an immediate unsafe situation or action, YELL OUT at the top of your lungs, "CEASE FIRE! CEASE FIRE! CEASE FIRE!"

The firing line will shut down until the situation is resolved. SAFETY is EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY while on the FRPC Property.

RANGE POLICIES

1. All shooters and bystanders must provide State ID, State DL, or Passport which will be held in the Range House while on the FRPC property. All Non-Members will be required to complete all required documentation needed to enter the facility for each visit.
2. All shooters, without exception, are required to pay an environmental fee for each visit. Bystanders are excluded.
3. Approved hearing and eye protection must be worn by all shooters and bystanders within 50 feet of a live fire range. Persons in closed vehicles (windows rolled up) are exempt from eye protection rule.
4. All rifle ammunition will be checked in by FRPC staff at the Range House during check-in, prior to shooting.
5. Any shooter under the age of (18) must be with their parent/legal guardian or a "designated agent" (who is at least 21 years of age) with proper forms to be allowed on FRPC property. While the minor is shooting, they MUST be supervised, one on one, by a non-shooting adult. The adult will be standing close enough to reach the firearm and/or shooter to prevent handling errors.
6. Impaired shooters or bystanders are prohibited at FRPC. This includes impairments caused by, but not limited to, prescription drugs, OTC medications, alcohol, and/or THC/Cannabis whether medicinal or recreational. Possession and/or use of these substances, including O'Doul's, Sharps etc. are not permitted on FRPC property. If the Range Master witnesses possession of, or suspects you consumed any of the before mentioned substances, you will be asked to leave the FRPC Property.
7. No photography is permitted without permission from the FRPC Board of Directors. This includes cell phones, cameras and videos.
8. Only approved paper and steel targets can be used at FRPC within the approved impact areas. Do not shoot at target frames, bases, rocks, cans, wood, bottles etc.
9. Targets may be placed from 5 to 50 yards on the lower level of the range. Targets on the upper level must be placed in the permanent tracks provided. Do not take mobile target bases past the lower levels.
10. Range 2 & 3- Use the stairs at the right and left sides of the 50 yard berms to get to the upper levels. PLEASE DO NOT TAKE YOUR OWN PATH!
Member's Range 6- Use the stairs in the middle of the 50 yard berm. PLEASE DO NOT TAKE YOUR OWN PATH!
11. Range 4- Shotgun Range Only, no other types of firearms please. One shooter at a time. Shooters may stand anywhere between the table and the yellow safety chains.
12. **HOLSTERED HANDGUNS OR SLING CARRIED RIFLES, DRAW AND FIRE OR FAST DRAW, UNSIGHTED OR UNCONTROLLED RAPID FIRE IS NOT PERMITTED.**
13. FRPC rented property: The renter is responsible for any damages incurred.
14. **NO HUNTING ALLOWED ANYWHERE ON FRPC PROPERTY.**
15. Please leave the range as clean as or cleaner than when you arrived. Empty cases should be pushed forward of the firing line, trash placed in trash cans, shooting stools placed back on top of shooting benches, target bases placed just in front of shooting benches within impact area, and check to make sure you recover all equipment before you leave the area. FRPC is not responsible for lost/stolen/forgotten property.
16. To maintain the highest standard of safety, unsafe firearm handling will result in any member, guest, day shooter or bystander being asked to leave the FRPC property immediately. All fees paid will be forfeited. The incident will be brought to the attention of the FRPC Board of Directors, and further action will be up to their discretion.
