All matches except January, March, May & November will be 3 strings of 2 convertible sighters¹ and 15 shots for record at 880 yards, fired two to a mound.² Competitors without known zeroes will be accommodated prior to the match, notify the match director if this applies to you. The January, March, June, & November matches will be 4 strings of 2 convertible sighters¹ and 15 shots for record at 600 yards, fired two to a mound.² Competitors without known zeroes will be accommodated prior to the match, notify the match director if this applies to you. These 3 matches will be NRA Approved for classification purposes. Any 2 of these 3 matches will provide the 120 record shots necessary for an NRA Mid-Range Classification. The Fresno Open (May 23-24) match program will be distributed separately.

Match fees for all matches except Fresno Open (May): \$25.00

Juniors welcome. Match fee for shooters under 21: \$5

For the three 600-yard matches, there will be an additional \$5 fee for those shooters who want their scores sent to the NRA for classification purposes.

Shooters who are new to NRA High Power must attend a Practice / Workday before attending their first match. We will be glad to offer assistance and information.

All matches begin at 9:00 a.m. Squadding at 8:30 a.m. near the range house. Please be early.

Practice / Workdays commence at 8:30 a.m. Please call ahead to find out what work will be done, and what tools to bring.

We have practice days most Tuesdays throughout the year. **DO NOT SHOW UP**, without texting or emailing me first, to confirm the practice day is occurring, and start time.

All matches will be conducted using ShotMarker electronic targets. Your ammunition must have an on-target velocity of at least 1250 fps to reliably register. AR-15's and shorter barreled .308's may have difficulty at 880 yards, though the correct ammunition can often solve this problem.

Please bring a fully charged wi-fi capable tablet or smartphone. If you don't have such a thing, please let me know, as I have a couple extras.

All Children must be supervised by a non-shooting adult.

Typical elevation adjustments are needed for 600, & 880 yards, assuming you have a 100 yard zero; due to the many different cartridges, bullets, and velocities being used, these numbers are not exact but will get your 1st shot on the target in nearly every case.

From 100 yards to 600 yards: Come up 14 minutes or 3.9 mil.

From 100 yards to 880 yards: Come up 27 minutes or 7.7 mil.

¹Convertible sighters: The competitor gets two sighting shots. After shooting both sighting shots the competitor may choose from three options: Take both sighters as record shots, take only the second sighter as a record shot, or take neither sighter as a record. Taking only the first sighter as a record is not an option.

²Two to a mound: This is International Fullbore style shooting. Two competitors per firing point, alternating shots, and scoring for one another.
